### **PRIVACY STATEMENT**

A Privacy Statement explains what information Inverclyde Masters Swimming Club hold about you, why it is held and how you can have the information removed from the Club's files if you so wish.

#### **Why the Club is sending you this information**

A new law - the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into effect in May 2018 and effects the way Charities and Organisations like Inverclyde Masters Swimming Club keep information about their supporters. That is why the Club is sending to you a copy of the Club's Privacy Statement.

#### **What information does the club hold about you and why?**

The information that is held about you is the Contact information you submit on an Entry form for the Club's Annual Swimming Meet.

This information is important because it enables the Club to provide you directly with information relating to the Swim Meet.

#### **Who does the Club share your personal information with?**

Out with the Club's Swim Meet Organising Committee your personal information is only supplied to "Mail Chimp", a Company engaged by the Club, to distribute related Swim Meet information directly to individual Swim Meet Entrants.

#### **How long does the club keep your information?**

The Club keeps your information for as long as it is required for the purpose for which it was intended. The Club does this with your consent; this being implied when you submitted a Swim Meet Entry Form.

However you have the right to ask, following the conclusion of the specific Swim Meet for which it was supplied, not to retain your personal information.
